Study Visit Participation Conditions

Eligibility

1. Participation is open to persons resident in a Member State of the European Union, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Serbia or Ukraine.
2. Participants must have a good level of spoken English in order to take part actively in the event programme.
3. Persons from countries other than Member States of the European Union may participate provided that they fully cover their participation costs.

Selection

4. The number of places in each study visit is limited.
5. Prospective participants must apply by the deadline indicated using the form provided on the website: www.vote4all.eu.
6. Participants will be selected by the organisers. Priority will be given to:
 - a. persons with cerebral palsy or another disability;
 - b. caregivers of persons with cerebral palsy or another disability;
 - c. persons working in public authorities or non-governmental organisations concerned with the democratic participation of persons with a disability.

Consideration will also be given to gender balance and geographical diversity.

7. The organisers will inform applicants if they have been selected within one week after the deadline to apply for each event.

8. Participants should not book travel or accommodation until they have received confirmation from the organisers that they have been selected.

Travel

9. The travel costs of participants from countries other than the host country will be reimbursed by the organisers upon presentation of relevant receipts, up to the maximum indicated below:
 - a. Italy Study Visit: €250.
 - b. Slovenia Study Visit: €400.
 - c. Portugal Study Visit: €300.
 - d. Netherlands Study Visit: €250.
 - e. Brussels Study Visit: €250.

Participants must complete and return the expense claim form provided by the organisers at the latest by two weeks after the event.

10. Participants from the host country must cover their own travel costs to and from the event.
11. Transfer between venues during the event will be covered by the organisers.

Accommodation

12. The accommodation costs of participants in the Slovenia, Portugal and Brussels Study Visits will be covered by the organisers.
13. The accommodation costs of participants in the Italy and Netherlands Study Visits will be reimbursed by the organisers upon presentation of relevant receipts, up to the maximum indicated below:
 - a. Italy Study Visit: €150 per person per night for two nights.
 - b. Netherlands Study Visit: €120 per person per night for two nights.

Participants must complete and return the expense claim form provided by the organisers at the latest by two weeks after the event.

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Personal assistance

14. If required, participants may be accompanied by a personal assistant. The travel and accommodation costs of the personal assistant will be covered in the same way as for a regular participant.

Multiple participation

15. It is possible to participate in more than one event in the course of the project but priority will be given to applicants who have not yet participated in an event.

Cancellation

16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone an event.
17. When booking travel or accommodation, participants are strongly recommended to take out travel cancellation insurance or to select a flexible rate.
18. Participants who wish to cancel their participation are kindly asked to do so as early as possible in order to allow another applicant to take their place.
19. Travel and accommodation costs can only be reimbursed for participants who actually attend an event.

Evaluation

20. Participants undertake to respond to the evaluation forms provided by the organisers, including on behalf of the European Commission, after the event.

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
