Participation Conditions

Eligibility

1. a) Participation in online events is open to all.
b) Participation in in-person events is open to persons resident in a Member State of the European Union or third country participating in the EU Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values (CERV) Programme (Albania, Bosnia Herzegovina, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, Northern Macedonia, Serbia, Ukraine).
2. Participants must have a good level of spoken English in order to take part actively in the event programme.

Selection for in-person events

3. The number of places in each in-person event is limited.
4. Prospective participants must apply by the deadline indicated using the form provided on the website: www.voice4all.eu.
5. Participants will be selected by the organisers. Priority will be given to:

- a. persons with cerebral palsy or another disability;
- b. caregivers of persons with cerebral palsy or another disability;
- c. persons working in public authorities or non-governmental organisations concerned with the democratic participation of persons with a disability;
- d. persons who have not yet participated in another event during the project.

Consideration will also be given to gender balance and geographical diversity.

6. The organisers will inform applicants if they have been selected within one week after the final deadline to apply for each event. Please note that the initial deadline may be extended.
7. Participants should not book travel until they have received confirmation from the organisers that they have been selected.

Travel to in-person events

8. The travel costs of participants from countries other than the host country will be reimbursed by the organisers upon presentation of relevant receipts, up to the maximum indicated below:
 - a. Slovenia event, June 2026: €400.
 - b. France event, October 2026: €300.
 - c. Luxembourg event, November-December 2026: €300.
 - d. Portugal event, February 2027: €300.
 - e. Ukraine event, April 2027: €400.
 - f. Final event in Brussels, September 2027: €300.

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Participants must complete and return the expense claim form provided by the organisers at the latest by two weeks after the event.

9. Participants from the host country must cover their own travel costs to and from the event.

10. Transfer between venues during the event will be covered by the organisers.

Accommodation at in-person events

11. The accommodation costs of participants will be covered by the organisers for the maximum number of nights indicated in the respective event programme.

Participants may extend the duration of the accommodation at their own cost.

Personal assistance

12. If required, participants may be accompanied by a personal assistant. The participation of the personal assistant will be counted and their travel and accommodation costs will be covered in the same way as for a regular participant.

Multiple participation

13. It is possible to participate in more than one event in the course of the project but priority will be given to applicants who have not yet participated in an event.

Cancellation

14. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone an event.

15. When booking travel or accommodation for an in-person event, participants are strongly recommended to take out travel cancellation insurance or to select a flexible rate.

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16. Participants who wish to cancel their participation are kindly asked to do so as early as possible in order to allow another applicant to take their place.

17. Travel costs can only be reimbursed for participants who actually attend an event.

Evaluation

18. Participants undertake to respond to the evaluation forms provided by the organisers, including on behalf of the European Commission, after the event.

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
